The Vermont International Film Foundation is thrilled to offer an **exclusive excursion** to a new and unique four-day film festival – **The Nitrate Picture Show** at George Eastman House's vintage and renovated Dryden Theater in Rochester, NY. This is a special event to celebrate VTIFF's 30th anniversary.

The Nitrate Picture Show will present the rare opportunity to see vintage 35mm nitrate prints, glowing on the silver screen, from the collection of George Eastman House and other international archives. Travel will be in a comfortable vehicle with driver, accompanied by a film scholar and the cost includes travel, accommodation, festival pass, and some meals. Seats are very limited.
